

# §113.60. Social Studies Advanced Studies (2020)

The student will investigate, independently or collaboratively, a problem, issue, or concern within a selected profession or discipline **SSAS.C.1**

- a** analyze the relationship between his or her interests and career/discipline **SSAS.C.1.A**

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- b** review literature from varied sources from the selected career or discipline **SSAS.C.1.B**

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- c** identify a problem, issue, or concern **SSAS.C.1.C**

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- d** survey and/or interview professionals to determine the appropriateness of a project **SSAS.C.1.D**
