**Demonstrate comprehension of fictional texts and use word analysis strategies**

**1 Understand the meaning of words in passages that are read to the student or that the student reads.** R-7.1

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**2 Answer questions about a fiction passage that is read to the student or that the student reads.** R-7.2

CC. The passage could range from two medium sentences with five to seven words to a paragraph with up to five sentences. R-7.2.CC

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**5 Identify a character, setting, or event in a story that is read to the student or that the student reads.** R-7.5

CC. The story including a character, setting, or event could range from two medium sentences with five to seven words to a paragraph with up to five sentences. R-7.5.CC

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**7 Identify information or an idea in a fiction passage that is read to the student or that the student reads.** R-7.7

CC. The passage containing information or an idea could range from two medium sentences with five to seven words to a paragraph with up to five sentences. R-7.7.CC

**1 Understand the meaning of words in passages that are read to the student or that the student reads.** R-7.1

CC. The words could be shown with or without a graphic representation or could appear in a sentence. R-7.1.CC

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**3 Answer questions about a nonfiction text that is read to the student or that the student reads.** R-7.3

CC. The nonfiction text could range from two medium sentences with five to seven words to a paragraph with up to five sentences. R-7.3.CC

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**4 Answer questions about the main idea of a nonfiction text that is read to the student or that the student reads.** R-7.4

CC. The nonfiction text with a main idea could range from two medium sentences with five to seven words to a paragraph with up to five sentences. R-7.4.CC

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**6 Identify an individual, event, or idea in nonfiction text that is read to the student or that the student reads.** R-7.6

CC. The nonfiction text including an individual, event, or information could range from two medium sentences with five to seven words to a paragraph with up to five sentences. R-7.6.CC
